### Sidmouth Sailing Club Fees and Membership Categories

- ( ) Individual Adult -over 18 (£80) Applies to a single sailing adult only and does not include partner/spouse.
- ( ) Family – one sailing (£85) Open to one or two cohabiting adults and their children under the age of 18 or 21 in full time education and living at the same home address or university with one sailing member. This category shall have one vote per adult.
- ( ) Family – two plus sailing (£105) Open as above but with two or more sailing members.
- ( ) Non Sailing (£45) Open to Adults who do not sail but wish to hold Officer, Committee membership or race officer or patrol boat duties and includes similar benefits for cohabiting partner/spouse.
- ( ) Cadet 16 – 25years (£50) Open to those who are not part of a Family Membership. Cadets under 18 have no vote.
- ( ) Junior under 16 (£30) Open to those under the age of 16 and not part of a Family Membership. Juniors have no vote
- ( ) Holiday member (28 consecutive days) (£45)
- ( ) Boat Parking (£62 per boat)
- ( ) Kayak (£24 per kayak) subject to availability and use on a first come first served basis. Payment of the fee **does not** guarantee a space which must be confirmed by the membership secretary annually before a boat or kayak is parked.

 (2) Only adult sailing members and non-sailing members at the discretion of the General Committee may apply for a kayak space which generally shall be allocated on the basis of one space per individual membership, and a maximum of two spaces for family membership. Additional spaces may be allocated if space allows and are available.  
 (3) Kayak storage is not available to Sidmouth Sailing Club Supporters’ Club Members.  
 (4) Neither boat nor kayak spaces are transferable from Member to Member and must be surrendered to the Membership Secretary for reallocation from the waiting list.

## New Membership Forms

### Explanation for the change

HRMC has issued new rules and guidelines that clubs have to comply with in order to remain a Community Amateur Sports Club. This has had an effect on Sidmouth Sailing Club and the way we operate, therefore some changes have had to be made in order for us to comply with these new rules and guidelines. We now have to show that at least 50% of our membership participates in the activities of the club. (That's on at least 12 occasions throughout the year) However, it is recognised that some people wish to join the club but perhaps not be involved in activities of any kind, i.e. partner of a sailor, children/parents of sailors etc. To address this anomaly, and to comply with the new guidelines, we have taken advice given out by the RYA, and have now created a new group entitled 'Sidmouth Sailing Club Supporters Club'. This will allow us as a club, to have members join that do not wish to participate in 'on the water' activities but use the club on a more social basis. This membership does not preclude those joining under this category from assisting the club in other ways and would still have the benefit of being covered under the clubs insurance. In short those members joining under the category of 'Supporters Club' would not count toward the total number of members where 50% need to be 'active'.

### Guidance on how the form should be completed

The membership renewal form has been revised to reflect the changes as outlined above. The form now requires you to clearly identify which membership you and each of your family members are applying for. Below are some guidelines on how to complete the 'new look' forms.

Anyone participating on any of the water-based activities (including Kayaking) must take membership under one of the categories under 'Sailing Club' membership. Any adult, cadet or junior taking 'sailing Club' membership would be encouraged to make every effort be to assist the club by participating in activities (see list) on at least 12 occasions throughout the year.

Those opting for 'Supporters Club' membership (old social membership) would not be required to participate as above but would be most welcome to assist with any non water based activities if they so wish.

**IMPORTANT** – Please clearly identify each family member as either Sailing Club or Sailing Supporters Club by including them on the appropriate form.

To add to the confusion there are new DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS coming into effect this year which means that you have to tick the boxes to state that you agree to the club storing your data which we have always done responsibly and never pass it on to third parties. It also means that all members over 18 need to sign the forms
