1 Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the RYA, this Notice of Race, the National Scorpion Class Rules, and Local Sailing Instructions.

2 Advertising

Advertising is in accordance with the National Scorpion Class Rules.

3 Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Scorpion Class.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form at Registration on Saturday 9th June 2018.

4 Fees

The Entry Fee is £30.00 per Boat (or £15 where both helm or crew are 18 or under on 1st Jan 2018) (cheques made payable to Sidmouth Sailing Club).

5 Schedule

5.1 Registration: Saturday 9th June 2018 from 09.30.

5.2 First Race and Subsequent Races: The scheduled time of the First Race is 13.00 on the 9th June. Subsequent races to be advised in the Local Sailing Instructions but the last race to be sailed on Sunday 10th June 2018 shall not start after 15.00. Briefing 11.45 on 9th June. The intention is to sail 4 races on Saturday, 4 races on Sunday. A maximum of 8 races will be sailed over the 2 days.

6 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available after 09.30 on 9th June 2018 at the Club.

7 Venue

Sidmouth Sailing Club, The Esplanade Sidmouth, Devon. EX10 8BG.

8 Berthing

Boats shall be kept in the Club boat park.

9 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10 Reducing the Use of Plastic

Sidmouth Sailing Club is reducing the use of plastic. Bottles of water will not be available to purchase, but there will be free tap water and competitors are welcome to have their own bottles filled up. Paper bags are likely to be used for sandwiches, please provide your own waterproof bag for putting them into to take afloat.
